

ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 5-005

A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE PAY OF THE ELECTIONS DIRECTOR

- 2 **WHEREAS,** Each fall and winter semester, an Elections Director is hired by the Student General Council with the advice and consent of the University Council; **AND**
- 4 **WHEREAS,** After being confirmed, the Elections Director works for approximately eight weeks per semester during which he/she/they must be available at all times via email or phone for questions from candidates; **AND**

- 8 **WHEREAS,** The Elections Director carries numerous duties including weekly reports to the Assembly, confirming enrollment and candidate eligibility, preparing candidate applications, presiding at the mandatory candidate meeting, administering the “vote.umich.edu” website, scrubbing and announcing results, emailing the entire student body to inform them of elections, presiding over University Elections Commission meetings and serving as an ex-officio member, creating ballots, debriefing the Assembly after each election, and many more time-consuming tasks; **AND**

- 16 **WHEREAS,** The Elections Director is currently paid \$500 per semester; **AND**
- 18 **WHEREAS,** In previous years, the Student General Council set the salary at \$250 for the fall semester and if the Elections Director decided to continue in his/her/their role for the winter semester, he/she/they received a pay of \$750, as this was a way to incentivize the Elections Director to stay in his/her/their position for consistency and experience; **AND**

- 22 **WHEREAS,** It is in the best interest of the Central Student Government to offer a competitive salary to the Elections Director, and to incentivize that Elections Director to continue his/her/their work in the winter semester if he/she/they performed well during the fall semester; **THEREFORE BE IT**

- 28 **RESOLVED,** That the fall 2015 semester salary of the Elections Director should be set at \$600; **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- 30 **RESOLVED,** If a new Elections Director is hired for the winter 2016 semester, his/her/their salary should be set at \$600; **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- 32 **RESOLVED,** That if the fall 2015 Elections Director performs well, than the Student General Council will retain the Elections Director, and the Elections

34 Director should be paid a salary of \$800 for the winter 2016 semester as
an incentive to continue in his/her/their role in the winter 2016 semester;
AND BE IT FINALLY

36 **RESOLVED,** The Elections Director shall be paid with funds exclusively from the
Payroll account of Central Student Government.
