**A RESOLUTION TO MEMORIALIZE THE UNIVERSITY TO PRESERVE THE
BILLIARDS ROOM OF THE MICHIGAN UNION**

- WHEREAS,** The University of Michigan has a proud history that should be preserved and cherished because of its contribution to the University’s unique culture and identity; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** Those places on campus that have remained relatively unchanged over long periods of time connect us to the past, help us relate to alumni, allow alumni to better recall the fond memories of their time at this University, and give us a sense of the enduring quality of the University; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The Billiards Room of the Michigan Union has remained relatively unchanged since the current Michigan Union building was opened to students in 1919, despite significant renovations to the Michigan Union in the 1930s and 1950s¹; **THEREFORE BE IT**
- RESOLVED,** That the Central Student Government declares its support for the preservation of the Billiards Room of the Michigan Union and memorializes the University of Michigan to preserve the Billiards Room through the upcoming and future renovations of the Michigan Union; **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- RESOLVED,** That this Resolution shall be distributed to the President of the University of Michigan, Mark Schlissel; to the Vice President for Student Life, E. Royster Harper; and to the Michigan Union Board of Representatives.
