A RESOLUTION TO PLACE MORE RECYCLING BINS AROUND CAMPUS

- WHEREAS,** There are trash cans on almost every corner, some within a few hundred feet of each other; and there are hardly any recycling bins around campus; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** Students may find it easier to throw their recyclables into trash cans, reduces recycling, further hurting our campus; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** Many students will walk around campus or from class to class with a coffee cup or some sort of plastic and, wanting to get rid of it, will throw it in the closest possible bin; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The University of Michigan is a very green campus with a great reputation for sustainability¹, and there are already some initiatives that occur; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** More recycling bins should be implemented in student populated areas that do not currently have recycling bins such as the entrance to the ugli, outside of mason hall, Ross, South U near East Hall and the School of Information, and in between West and South Quad; **THEREFORE BE IT**
- RESOLVED,** That the legislative discretionary account will allocate up to \$2,000 to the Wolverine Conservation Club organization in order to purchase an extra-large 10 recycling bins, and team with CSG in order to make it an initiative to advertise better recycling habits.
